The Griffith Observatory is a famous Los Angeles landmark. The observatory has 60 exhibits centered on space-related themes and houses the Samuel Oschin Planetarium. Many tourists also come to this landmark because its location on the slope of Mt. Hollywood lends itself to spectacular views of Los Angeles and the Hollywood sign. Admission into the observatory exhibits is free; however, there is a small price to see the daily shows in the planetarium.

The La Brea Tar Pits, a 40,000 year old pool of hot tar, is a unique attraction in the center of Los Angeles. It is a rich excavation site for fossils of Ice Age animals that were unlucky enough to get caught in tar pits. The next-door Page Museum displays an impressive collection of archeological finds from site. Admission is \$7 for adults; \$4.50 for seniors 62 and over, Students with ID, and youths 13-17; \$2 for children 5-12, and free for children 5 and under.
